At the World Health Summit 2024 from October 13-15 in Berlin, leading international representatives from a wide range of fields will discuss the most pressing issues in global health. Under the motto "Building Trust for a Healthier World", the focus is on a healthier future for all. On the agenda, among other things: Pandemic threats and responses, mpox, health equity, climate change and health, artificial intelligence, antibiotic resistance and financing global health. Over 350 speakers and several thousand participants from all regions of the world from science, private sector, civil society and politics, including numerous ministers, are expected to attend.

A particular highlight will be the presentation of the first Investment Round of the World Health Organization (WHO) at the World Health Summit 2024. The aim of the Investment Round, which is co-hosted by Germany among others: To enable the WHO to prevent 40 million avoidable deaths caused by disease over the next four years through more reliable and at the same time more flexible funding. Speakers include German Chancellor Olaf Scholz and WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus.

The World Health Summit as a conference and strategic forum takes place every year in October in Berlin with around 3,000 participants on-site and more than 10,000 online and was founded in 2009 at Charité - Universitätsmedizin Berlin.
