Inventions demonstrated in this Tomorrow's Affordable Hosptial were selected according to two criteria: accessability i.e. affordable to all and their low environmental impact, i.e. sustainability. Taking a tour of the hospital, you may find a pharmacy equipped to detect counterfeit drugs or a high tech and digitalised radiology unit specialised for tropcial climate conditions at 10% of the market price. You may also discover how to wash your hands with soap while only consuming 10cc of water and for the more adventurous, you find how take a shower with a single litre of water... S.P.
