

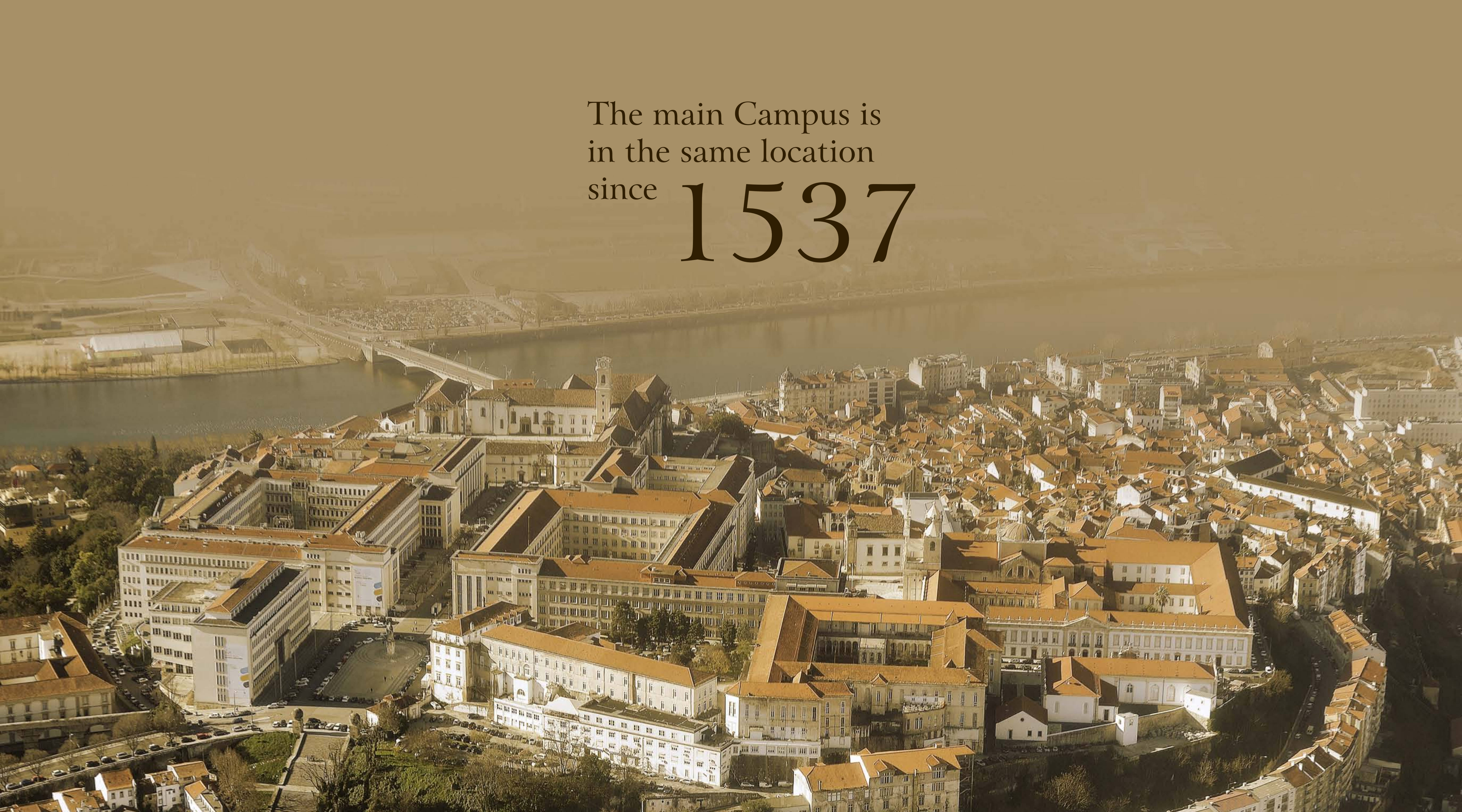

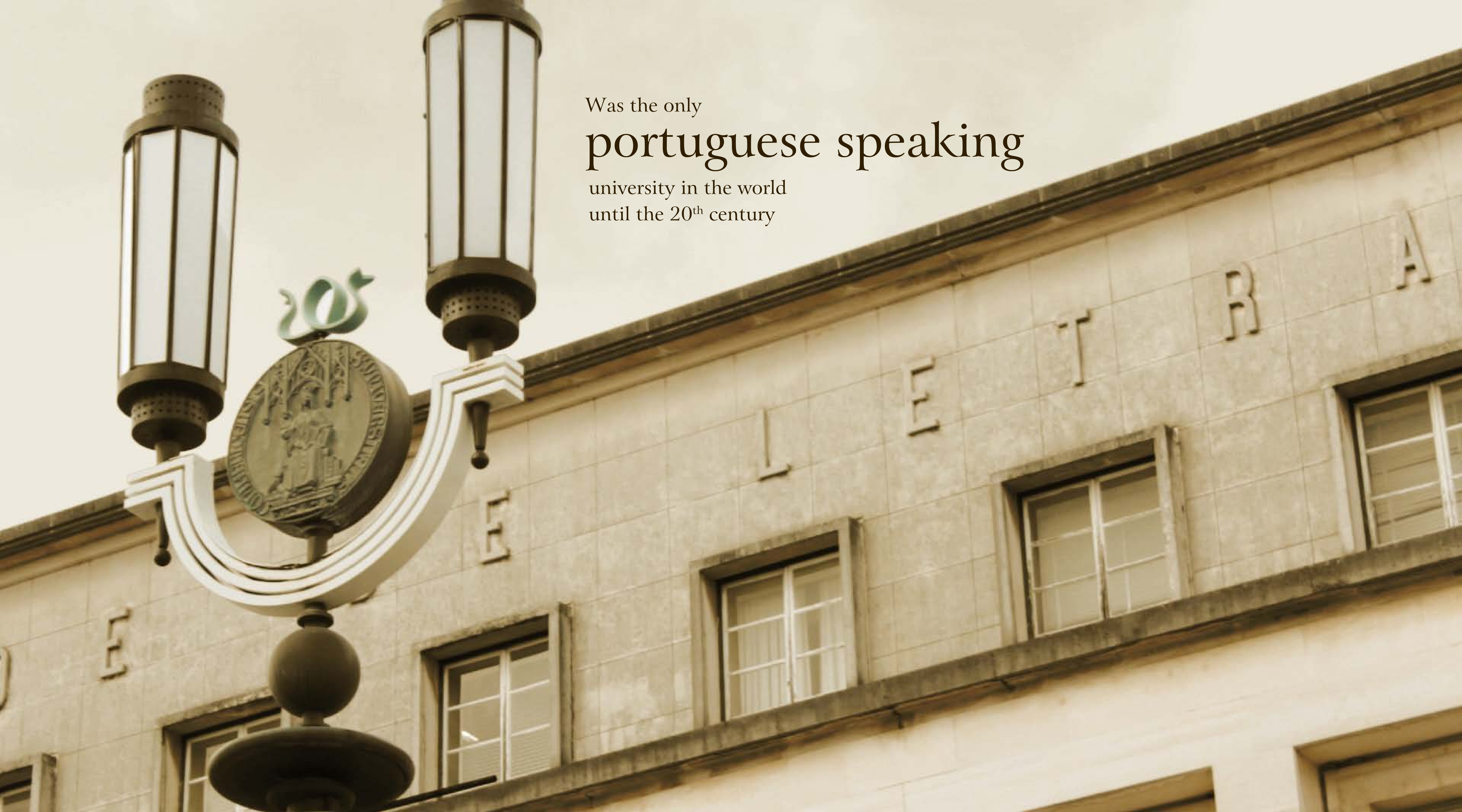


Founded in 1290. The University of Coimbra was

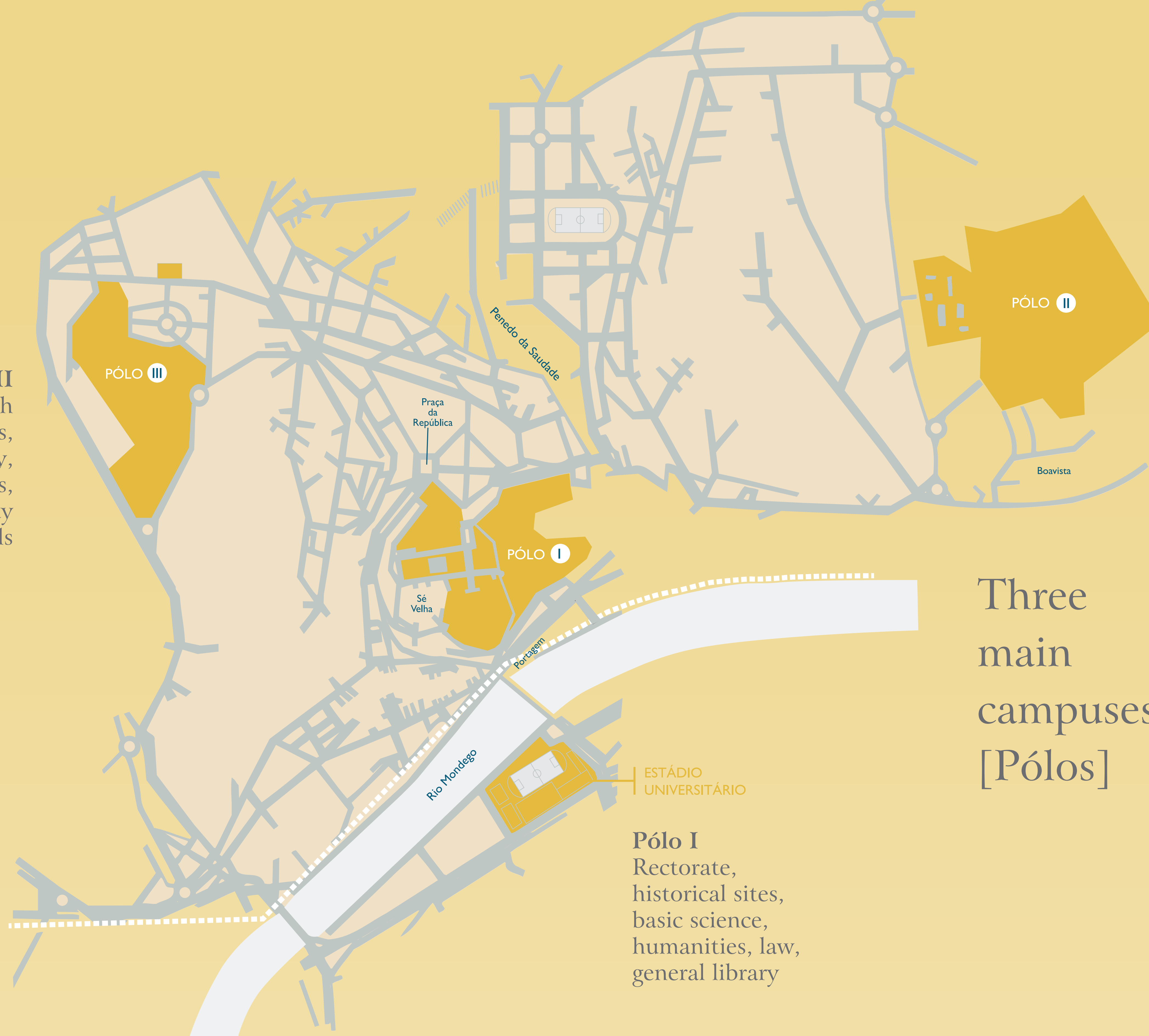
